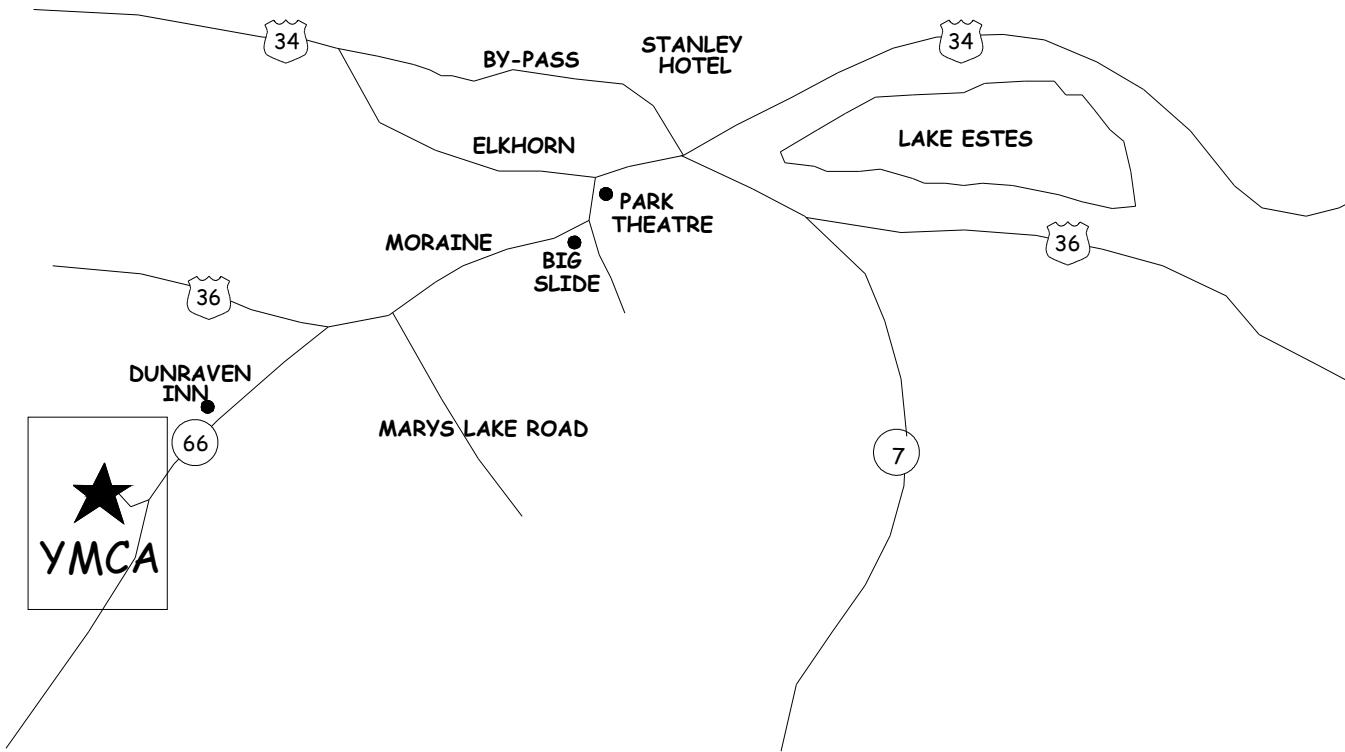

1. At Junction 34 – 36, turn **Left** onto Elkhorn Avenue and **stay in Left lane**.
2. Turn **Left** onto Moraine Ave. Then move **immediately into the right lane**.
3. When highway splits at a "Y", take the road to the **Right**. (The big slide will be on your left).
4. Drive 1.4 miles until the road splits again.
5. Turn **left** onto Colorado 66 and continue for 2 miles. You will see a large YMCA sign on the right ... turn **right** and you are there!
6. Turn **left** just inside the camp entrance and follow the road to the last main building on your left (by the stop sign).
