Inspection and Joint Briefing – Thursday 6:00

- Chorus Inspection will be first. We will be Singing "One Song At A Time" for the uptune
 and "How We Sang Today" for the ballad. Vickie Maybury will start directing us during the
 Judges inspection and then all Directors are invited to come on stage to hear the sound and/or Direct
 during the inspection time period.
- Quartet Inspection will start at approximately 6:40 with Last Call as our mic testers.
- We will start the joint briefing as soon as the Judges Inspection is completed.
 - Chorus Directors and Team Leaders will have the opportunity to walk the traffic pattern. (we will identify the quick change chorus areas for dual members)
 - Quartets will also walk the traffic pattern and will be able to walk on stage and sing for 3 minutes on Thursday evening. (this will occur in the order of appearance)

Important Stage Notes

- 1. Quartets will ENTER the stage through curtains at Center Stage. Quartets will EXIT Stage Left.
- 2. ALL Choruses will ENTER Stage Right and EXIT Stage Left. (There are 2 videos on the Region 8 website walking the backstage pattern for your viewing pleasure.)
- 3. The rehearsal rooms/primp rooms for Quartets are backstage right at the venue. The rooms will have water and Kleenex only and access to a restroom. Anything else you need you should bring with you.
- 4. The Chorus rehearsal spaces AND warm-ups are at the Red Lion Hotel and will NOT have risers. They will have water available.
- 5. Those who purchased a digital recording, a link will be sent to each Quartet or Chorus contact soon after the contest weekend for you to download your performance.

There will be a FREE Livestream available this year for the Quartet and Chorus competitions. The link will be posted on the Rocky Mountain Region 8 Convention Page prior to the event starting. The stage times are already available on the website so your friends and family can plan ahead.

Saturday @ 7:30 PM

Please join us for the Region 8 Awards and Show of Champions on Saturday night at 7:30 in the Grand Ballroom on the 1st floor at the Red Lion Hotel. This event has become one of my favorite parts of the weekend. We had such a great time last year celebrating each other, visiting and listening to our friends perform! We hope everyone can join us again this year and make it another night to remember!

Performers at the Show of Champions will be:

- Quartets 1st, 2nd, and 3rd place and the Audience Choice Open Division Quartet (5 minutes each)
- Choruses (5 minutes each) please note if you win more than one of these awards you will only perform once.
 - 1st Place Mid Sized and 1st Place Small Sized chorus
 - o 1st, 2nd and 3rd place overall in the Region
 - o Bravo Award Open Division Chorus
- The order for the Show of Champions and approximate performance times will be available at the Briefing on Thursday and after each contest.

Contest Transportation and Parking

- Vans will be available to take Quartets to the Civic Center for competition on Friday.
- A trolley will be available to take audience members to the Civic Center on Friday to watch the Quartet competition. The first trolley will leave the Red Lion at 10:25 am on Friday and take members to the venue. The trolley will leave the hotel at 10:45, 11:15, 11:45 and 12:15. The trolley will be at the Civic Center around 5:30 (after the Quartet contest) and return guests to the Red Lion. The trolley will make several trips until all guests are picked up.
- Buses will be available to take Choruses to the Civic Center for competition on Saturday.
- Parking at the Civic Center there is a parking garage, the fee is \$4.00/day on Monday Friday 8:00 to 5:00 pm. Outside of those hours, parking is free in the garage and open all day. There is some off street parking. Please do NOT park behind the building near the backstage entrance doors.
- There will be an Audience bus on Friday from the Red Lion to the Civic Center for the Quartet Competition.
- Buses will be available at the Civic Center Quartet Contest and Chorus Content to return you to the hotel.

Members with Mobility Concerns – please note that there are about 4 steps to negotiate as you are exiting the stage. If you have a member with mobility concerns, please notify Shaye Krcil, Competition Coordinator, so alternative plans can be arranged.
